



Don't Forget the Apostrophe!!

It is very easy to forget something as small as the apostrophe. It seems so small and insignificant. However, an apostrophe error is, in a way, as problematic as a spelling error. Make sure you don't forget it.

So when do you use the apostrophe?

You use it for the following:

When you want to show possession:

I am going over to **Graham's** house tomorrow.

When you are using a contraction:

I'm going over to visit Graham tomorrow.
